Denison Named Chairman of House Infrastructure and Transportation Funding Committee

Jefferson City- Today, on the first day of the 2010 Legislative Session in Jefferson City, House Speaker Ron Richard named Representative Charlie Denison (R-Springfield) chairman of the House Infrastructure and Transportation Funding Committee. Denison previously served as vice-chairman of the committee.

"I am truly honored by Speaker Richard's support," Denison said. "While Missouri has made dramatic infrastructure improvements in recent years, we must continue to look at innovative solutions to our state's infrastructure challenges. I look forward to working with my colleagues on the committee to address Missouri's many transportation and infrastructure needs."

The House Infrastructure and Transportation Funding Committee was formed by Speaker Ron Richard during the 2009 legislative session to consider bills relating to the funding and development of the state's infrastructure including roads, highways, and bridges.

"Representative Denison has been one of our most vocal leaders on the issue of transportation.
